The Residential Program Center Shelter (RPC) is a 44-bed shelter for men and women, run in partnership with Arlington County Department of Human Services. New Hope Housing took over operations of RPC on February 3rd, 2020.

Services include case management, advocacy, employment assistance, housing assistance, meals, and connection with community resources and programs. The Residential Program Center Shelter is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Case management is offered to all clients and assists with developing an individualized plan to address financial stability, increasing employment, assessing for housing type, and assists with how clients can remain permanently housed.
