Individuals receiving assessments may be referred for further services within the Community Services Board or receive a referral to a private provider.

The facility includes the Engagement Center which offers services to people who are reluctant to enter Community Services Board services but could benefit from medication assisted treatment (for substance use disorders) and time limited supportive counseling.
