The <u>Regional Adult Education Program</u> in Gate City, VA offers adult education classes for Lee, Scott, and Wise counties and the City of Norton. All adult education classes are free and have open entry and open exit. Adults enter any class meeting and finish when they meet their goals. Classes are offered for basic reading, GED preparation, English as a Second Language, and distance learning. All students are assessed for their ability in reading and math. Working with the teacher, adults complete lessons in their areas of weakness. Adults have free textbooks, supplies, and access to the Internet at most sites. The GED is given at least monthly in Wise, Norton, and Jonesville, and on-demand or near-daily GED testing is available in Gate City.
