The main entry for homeless individuals in need of temporary housing is the Lynchburg Community Action Group (Lyn-CAG), at 915 Main Street, even though the shelter is located at 620 Fifth Street in Lynchburg.

The Hand-Up Lodge is a 28-bed facility and utilizes the services of many community agencies to assist clients.
