Program (HIP) is to prevent homelessness because of eviction or foreclosure of individuals and families and to provide time-limited financial and housing counseling assistance to low income individuals and families experiencing a financial crisis who are at risk of homelessness or who are currently homeless. HIP assistance is intended to facilitate their ability to maintain or obtain permanent housing.
