Virginia G3 is a tuition assistance opportunity for Virginia residents who qualify for state financial aid and who have a total household income that is less than 400 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. The program offers assistance for students in five of the most in-demand industries in Virginia:

- Early Childhood Education,
- Healthcare,
- Information Technology,
- Public Safety,
- Skilled Trades (construction and manufacturing).

G3 is a last-dollar scholarship that, with other financial aid, could bring the cost of college down to zero. Full-time students, receiving the maximum Pell grant may receive additional benefits to help pay for the cost of living. <u>Eligibility information</u>, <u>participating colleges</u>, and other <u>G3 Frequently Asked Questions</u> are available on the website.

There are academic requirements to stay eligible for G3 benefits. As long as a student is on track to finish the program in three years, students can take a break and still keep their G3 scholarship.
