Veteran Burial Benefits

Veterans may be eligible for burial benefits such as burial expenses, transportation of the deceased to a VA national cemetery, a Government headstone or marker, a burial flag, and/or a Presidential Memorial Certificate. Burial benefits are dependent on whether the death is service-related or non-service-related.
